Results Achieved









pharmacists were trained in 3-weeks through SwipeRx. This represents 83% of all pharmacists using the app in November 2024, when the training was offered.



of those trained were women and 44% were from provinces outside the capital city Phnom Penh.



increase in pharmacists' ability to correctly advice clients diagnosed with diabetes regarding frequency and timing of at-home glucose measurement post-training.



increase in trained pharmacists' ability to correctly identify clients needing referral based on BP measurement.



increase in trained pharmacists' knowledge of hypertension medicines included in the Ministry of Health's essential Drug List.
